Given the anticipated customer base, we cannot see further safety precautions will be necessary.

Signs front and rear to encourage a quiet departure for the benefit of neighbours and the Village overall.

Taxi phone numbers to be readily available.

External noise checks to be made throughout licencing hours with particular attention to after 23:00 hours.

#### The Protection of Children from Harm

No minors allowed on the premises after 22:00 unless seated with Parents or Guardians, in the restaurant area only, and properly supervised by the same.

Proof of age and Challenge 21 schemes strictly adhered to throughout.


